Costs

There are 3 areas of costs associated with your Scouting experience.

Annual BSA Registration – National and Council fees. This covers BSA membership and insurance for 12 months. The current fee for NEW scouts is \$45 (\$85 if signed up after October 2026).

Pack Activity Fee – Also called Pack dues. This money goes to the Pack and covers supplies for den and pack meetings, activities, events, and awards. The fee for Pack 323 for the 2026-2027 scout year is \$150. Scouts are encouraged to “earn their way” by participating in annual fundraisers. Fall Popcorn Fundraiser & Spring Camp Card sales can help offset these costs and even earn a free week at summer camp!

Additional Costs – Uniform, handbook (K&1st only), and some scouting events and activities you can opt to participate in, such as campouts.
